Question- 1:

Statements:

Some grapes are apples

Some apples are bananas

All bananas are Guavas

Any guava is not a Pomegranate

Conclusions:

- I. Any grape is not a Pomegranate**
- II. Some guavas are grapes**

- IV. Any bananas is not a pomegranate**
